ASB organised a seminar in Neum

A German non-governmental organisation Arbeiter-Samariter-Bund (ASB) under the CARDS 2003 Programme of the European Commission in Bosnia and Herzegovina (BiH), is currently implementing the integrated return projects IRP-1-SA (Municipality of Centar, Novo Sarajevo and Novi Grad), IRP-2-SA (Goražde, Stari Grad, Ilidža and Visoko) and IRP-4-NW (Bihać, Prijedor and Sanski Most). A so-called "Initial Training" is planned in the project methodology of above-mentioned projects and it is related to introduction of a comprehensive "Manual for Implementation of Integrated Return Projects". This manual was elaborated by ASB in close co-operation with the European Commission, a Supervisory of the European Commission (AHT Group A.G), and all local authorities.

Manual is designed in two volumes: the first volume elaborates the implementation procedure related to implementation of integrated return projects while the second volume contains a necessary accompanying documentation which supports the implementation procedures. Furthermore, this manual is fully in accordance with relevant regulations in BiH and procedures of the European Commission and it represents a solid empiric foundation for implementation of the same and similar projects in the future (which will be carried out by the local authorities themselves). It also provides a possibility for fast and quality training of new staff who will work on these and similar issues on the basis of available procedures clearly defined in the manual.

In the light of above-mentioned, "Initial Training" for 140 participants which includes a detailed introduction of the "Manual for Implementation", was organised through a seminar entitled "Presentation of a Manual for Implementation of Integrated Return Projects in BiH". The seminar was held in organisation of ASB in Neum on Monday, 21 February 2005 until Friday, 25 February 2005 in the hotel "Stela".
