<b>Objectives and results of the action</b>					
<p><b>Wider Objective:</b> Provision of durable solutions for the IDP and refugee population within Serbia.</p> <p><b>Immediate Objectives:</b></p> <p>a) to support IDPs and refugees moving from private accommodation and collective centres to social housing in a protected living environment;</p> <p>b) to support IDPs and refugees through the development of accommodation solutions as are pre-fabricated housing and provision of building material;</p> <p>c) to support IDPs and refugees in developing sustainable livelihoods through business start-up activities and d) to include extremely vulnerable and marginalised domicile families in the resolution of their socio-economic status;</p> <p><b>Results:</b></p> <p>a) At least 25 apartment units for social housing in protected environment constructed and inhabited within 2 project municipalities (2 buildings) for 25 beneficiary families (approximately 80 individuals) currently residing in CCs, unregistered CCs or in extremely unconditional private accommodation;</p> <p>b) 46 beneficiary families (approximately 138 individuals) finalise the construction of their homes through the receipt of construction material and live under proper living conditions;</p> <p>c) 6 extremely vulnerable Roma IDP families (approximately 30 individuals) are able to move into their newly constructed pre-fabricated homes;</p> <p>d) 100 project beneficiaries receive training and mentoring support in business start-up and make a proper use of it;</p> <p>e) 50 most successful economic beneficiaries receive in-kind support for the start-up of their registered business and create self-employment;</p> <p>f) dissemination of best practices and lessons learned during the project available to and used by other project stakeholders and awareness on importance of caring for target groups risen;</p> <p>g) monitoring and evaluation activities performed during the whole duration of the action, providing smooth project implementation;</p> <p>h) Established coordination between government, civil and international structures, dealing with the target group obtained.</p>
